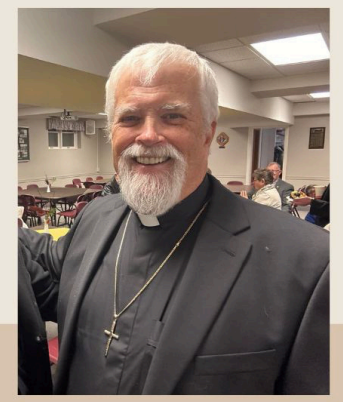


SACRED HEART
