ALL SOULS DAY CANDLELIGHT MASS

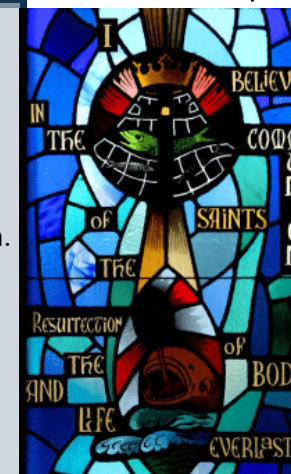
