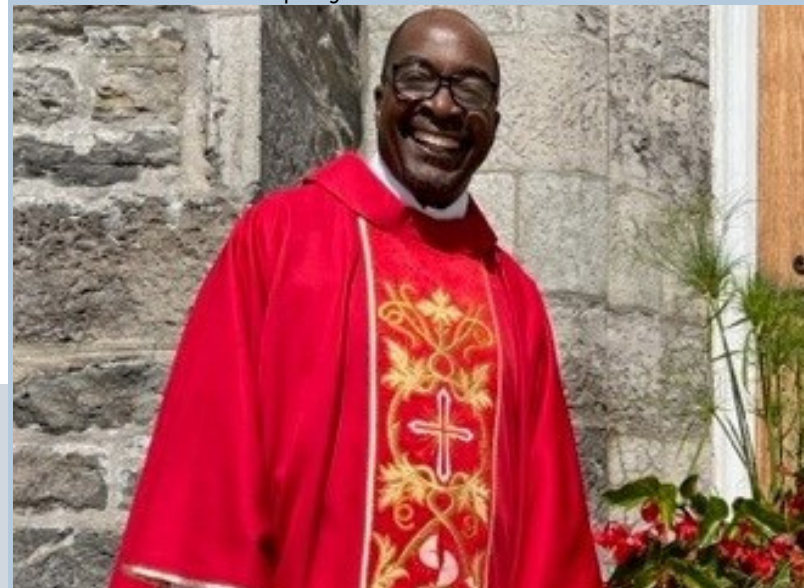

We will meet at St. Joseph's Church, Powassan at 12:30 pm on August 9th (Mass will be said that evening) and walk 130 km over five days to Holy Family Church, Britt where we will venerate relics of the Holy Canadian Martyrs. The pilgrimage will conclude with a Missa Cantata of the Assumption on August 15th at 9:00am, followed by brunch and farewells.
